I. most common types of neglect...

Within the category of neglect, physical neglect was the most commonly occurring type and included abandonment; medical neglect; inadequate nutrition, clothing, or hygiene; and leaving a young child unattended in a motor vehicle.⁴⁵

- I. less than 1/3 of CA/N cases are reported to Child Protective Services...**
 - " However, according to the Third National Incidence Study of Child Abuse and Neglect (NIS-3), less than one-third of child abuse and neglect cases are reported to CPS.43"**

Child Maltreatment Reports, 2005

- I. 3.3 million referrals**
 - A. 28.5% substantiated**
 - 1. birth to 3:
highest rate of victimization**

Sullivan, Vernon & Scanlon, 1987

- I. sexual abuse...**
 - "Available incidence data from the general population indicate that one in four girls and one in ten boys is sexually abused at some time prior to adulthood (Finkelhor, 1986)."**
 - A. 1 in 4 girls**
 - B. 1 in 10 boys**

Wang & Holton - 2007

- I. ...each year - close to 1,000,000 confirmed victims of child maltreatment**

Freundlich - 2007

- I. 2005: 3.6 million children reported as possible victims of CA/N**
