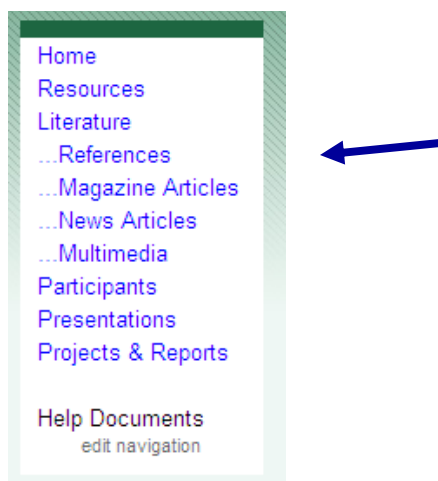


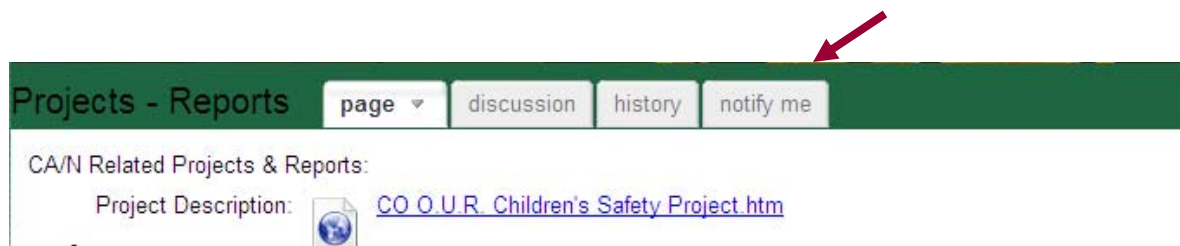
Step 6: Optional – AUTOMATIC NOTIFICATION OF PAGE UPDATES

(NOTE: You must be logged into the wikispace and you must have previously confirmed your email address for this option to function properly.)

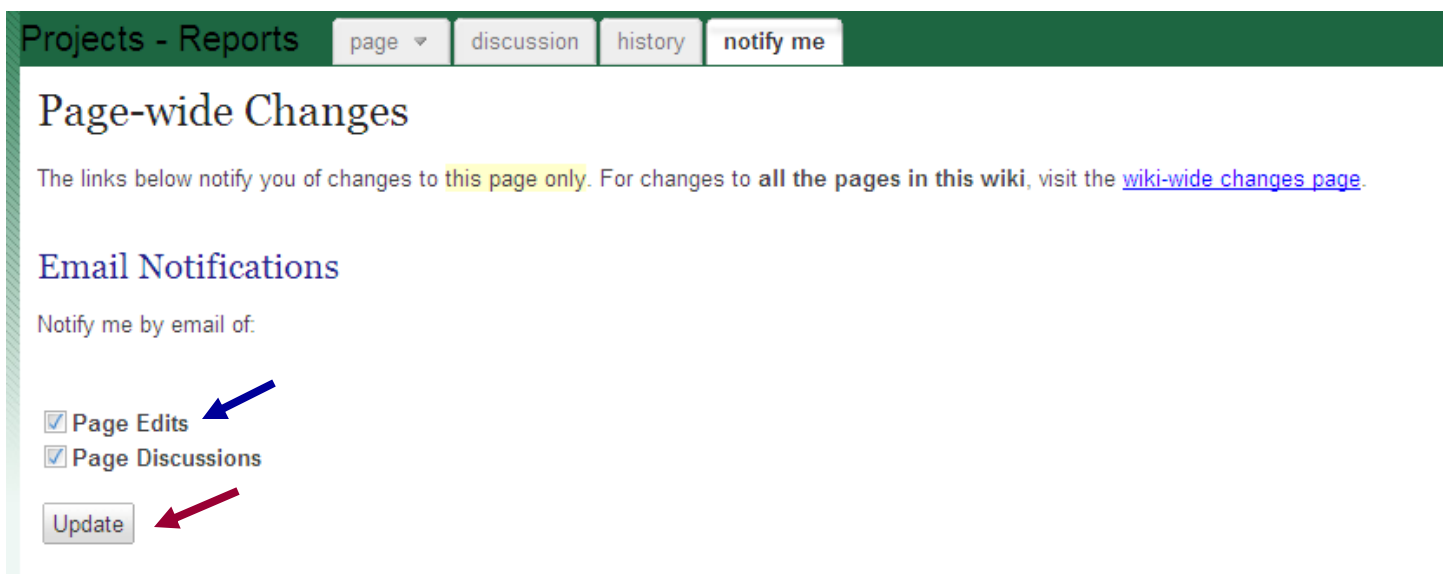
Click on the **page link** of the page you wish to monitor.




The page will open. Click the **“notify me”** tab.



Under “Email Notifications”, check the **Page Edits** and **Page Discussions** boxes. Click the **“Update”** button.




The page will refresh and verify that the email option has been updated.
