TEACH DREW X-RATED PICS, FONDLED BOY, CLAIM POLICE

A CITY SIGN LANGUAGE teacher was busted for allegedly rubbing a 9-year-old boy's crotch during an impromptu sex education lesson in a Manhattan school, police said yesterday.

To demonstrate "where babies came from," Diana Gonzalez allegedly drew pornographic pictures in the hearing-impaired child's notebook, a police source said. As she drew, the 6-foot, 155-pound woman ran her hands over the boy's upper thigh and rubbed his penis through his pants, according to court records.

The incident occurred on July 2 in the library at Public School 8- Luis Belliard School on W. 167th St., where Gonzalez was supposed to be teaching the child a one-on-one lesson, cops said.

The boy later showed his mother the drawings and told her of the touching, and the mom alerted authorities, police sources said. Gonzalez, 39, turned herself in after returning from a trip abroad, which she left for soon after the alleged attack, police sources said. She was arraigned Monday in Bronx Criminal Court on sexual abuse and endangering-the-welfare-of-a-child charges, court records show.

Gonzalez was released without bail. She was immediately reassigned to administrative duty when the allegations were made, school officials said.

A neighbor at Gonzalez's building in Riverdale, the Bronx, dismissed the child's account. "I don't believe it at all," said the neighbor, who declined to give her name. "She seems like a sweet, nice person."
